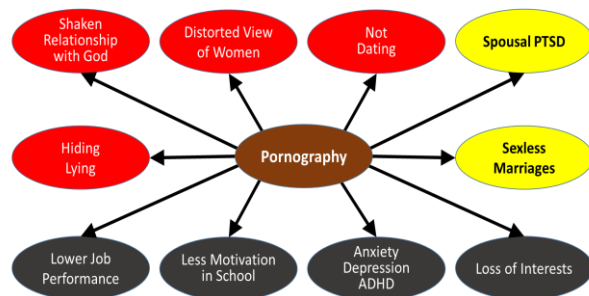
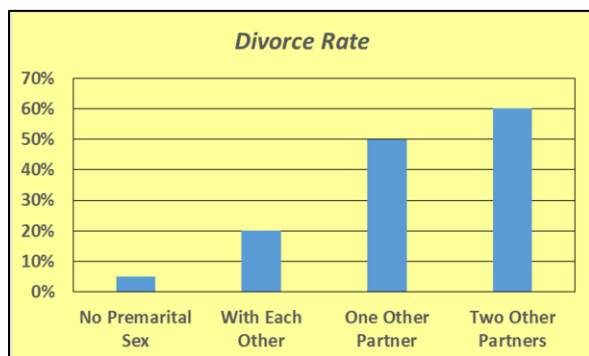


Resources for Having Important Talks
